FlexTemp Additive is a phenomenal success! Not only is it being used in cold temperatures, cold rooms and freezers, but contractors, as well as distributors, are using it in warmer weather to speed up an already fast set time. Use it on cool nights, cold, shady areas, or wherever you want to OPEN TO TRAFFIC QUICKER. It's also great for group demonstrations!

FlexPrime is used instead of normal priming with FlexKrete, where you have damp concrete or where you want to seal rusty metal (rebar, for instance). Apply it very thin. Thick is not better! FlexSealer 1000 (New, re-developed) is our new version sealer, to seal broadcast systems, use as a top-coat over FlexKrete or other coatings, and will stick to concrete, steel, wood, fiberglass, plastic (with proper surface prep), and is water-clear, or can be tinted. It is extremely tough, resistant to many chemicals, is water-based, and will dry in the sun in 15 minutes. This is like encapsulating with a strong plastic coating! We are already shipping our second run!

YES, THEY BELIEVE IT! No forms to build, just hand-fill the void, trowel smooth, and repaint the next hour! Can you imagine how MUCH LABOR AND MONEY THIS SAVES OUR CUSTOMERS? It's easy and looks great! INNOVATION! All contractors and cus-

tomers need to know about the "muck" bucket. Buy it at Walmart and most farm stores, it is a 15-20 gallon plastic or rubber pail in which FlexKrete can be thoroughly and efficiently mixed, rather than using a five



gallon pail. The "muck" bucket allows you to mix larger batches, and with the square paddle mixer, it is mixed easier and more thoroughly. MORE IMPORTANTLY, it allows one to do an entire job with a single pour. Most hand drills do not have the power to "push" a full five gallons of mixed material, but with the taller and wider container, it makes a 10-15 gallon job very simple and quick. The "muck" bucket is also extremely easy to keep clean. Wipe it out with a little acetone, or let it dry, and just pop it out. This simple \$15. piece of equipment replaces the old, standard way of thinking, which is to buy an expensive grout mixer, upward to 6-\$8,000. They break down, are terrible to transport, and are tedious to keep clean. For those who have not yet tried it, GET A "MUCK" BUCKET.

RETAIN THE

JOINTS. When repairing an area which incorporates a joint, one easy way to fix it is to fill the whole void with FlexKrete, allow it to cure, then, with a masonry saw cut the joint back in, and seal it with a joint filler. Always retain joint.
